1. **Entries close Wednesday, July 21, 2010. Dressage: July 14, 2010**
Entries will be accepted at the regular fees during the horse show for pre-entered/pre-paid horses. Horses not previously entered will be charged an additional \$10.00 office fee. Entries close 30 minutes prior to the start of show. Scratch sheet must be filled out 3 classes prior to scratched class or you will be charged.
RETURNED CHECK FEE \$30.00 If you did not pay any previous years entry, you are on cash only.
2. **MEMBERSHIP:** Each exhibitor will be required to purchase a single Chemung County Fair membership for \$10.00. *****NEW THIS YEAR***** extra membership passes can be ordered for trainers, parents ect... This enables you to get into the fair with no extra charge. Membership cards will be mailed approximately 1 week after entry/ check is received.
3. **PRE-ENTRY FORMS & FEES: Pre-entry forms will not be accepted unless signed by the owner/exhibitor/parent. ALL PRE-ENTRIES MUST BE PRE-PAID OR ACCOMPANIED BY A BLANK CHECK.** Entry fees for this show are tax deductible.
4. **STABLING: NO STALLS WILL BE RESERVED WITHOUT PAYMENT, ASSIGNMENTS ON A FIRST COME BASIS.** Stabling fees must accompany entries. NO REFUNDS FOR STALLS. Exhibitors remaining from the 4-H show must make early reservations or you may be asked to leave at the discretion of the stable manager. **All stall fees are as follows:** one day \$15.00 per stall, two days \$20.00 per stall, three days \$30.00 per stall, 4 days \$40.00 per stall. **Stalls are available at 6 pm each night prior to the show.** Anyone arriving prior to 6 pm without permission of the stable manager will be charged for an extra day.
BLOCK STABLING: ANY EXHIBITOR WISHING TO STABLE WITH ANOTHER EXHIBITOR MUST SUBMIT THEIR ENTRY FORMS/STABLING REQUESTS TOGETHER. Exhibitors who wish to share a tack stall must record the tack stall and submit payment with ONE entry form. **Showing off trailer fee is \$7.00**
5. **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** All horses entering the show grounds must have a negative Coggins test dated 2009-2010 and a current Rabies certificate. **All out of state horses must have a valid health certificate as per requirement of New York State vet.** In accordance with New York State law copies of Coggins, Rabies and Health Certificate must be presented before exhibitor numbers will be issued and must remain on file in the show office. All horses over the age of 3 months are required to have a rabies vaccination.
PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE send a copy of both ... WITH ... your entries.
6. **PRIZE MONEY:** Will be paid at the office against unpaid entries or by check within one week of show close. **No prize money will be paid in classes with less than four entries.**
7. **CAMPERS:** Campers and/or tents are to be in designated camping areas only. Camping spaces will be reserved on a first come basis, limited sites. Camper reservations must be made on entry form. There will be a **\$15.00 (per evening) charge** for campers and/or tents. Campers must display a camper sticker that may be obtained from the horse show office upon arrival.

8. **PARKING: IN THE INFIELD.** All exhibitors are required to park/drop their trailers and accompanying vehicles in designated areas. **Parking will be available on the hill behind the fire tower ... ONLY for those showing out of their trailers.** ALL other parking is available on the infield. All access roads must remain free of parked vehicles and any vehicles parked in restricted areas are subject to being towed at the owner's expense.
9. ADD/ **SCRATCHES:** Entries close 30 minutes prior to the start of show. Add sheet must be filled out 3 classes prior to class. Scratch sheet must be filled out 3 classes prior to class or you will be charged. Forfeited fees for scratched classes may not be used for added classes. **Horses not previously entered will be charged an additional \$10.00 office fee.**
10. AQHA rules will be used as guidelines for all Open Divisions and USEF rules will be used as guidelines for all Hunters & Jumper Divisions. Some rules custom designed for our show but are published in program.
11. Age of rider will be determined by their age as of January 1st of the current year. Age of horse will be determined as of January 1st of the year following its birth.
12. Youth under 18 years of age may not show a stallion in any class. **Youths under 14 years MUST wear an ASTM approved helmet when mounted. It's the law!**
13. All registered horses must have proof of registration. Animals improperly entered in a breed specific class will be disqualified.
15. Schooling will be available for all disciplines in the exercise/rubber arena adjacent to Barn 1 and in other rings as they are made available. (see map) All show rings will close ½ hour before classes begin.
16. The show chairperson has the right to cancel, add, combine, split and/or postpone any classes or the show if dangerous ring conditions exist, adverse weather conditions exist or if there are insufficient entries in the class (less than three).
17. Exhibitors must use the wash areas in a proper manner. **(clean up after yourself and your horse)** IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHEMUNG COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT REGULATIONS, NO HOSES ARE TO BE LEFT LYING IN ANIMAL WASTE.
18. If a situation occurs in any class that is not specifically covered by these rules, the judge's decision will be final. Anyone wishing to speak to any judge must have prior approval from the show chairperson.
19. For the purpose of Grand and Reserve awards, points will be accumulated on a single horse and rider combination. There must be at least 3 entries in a division for Grand and Reserve awards to be given.

REMINDER:

Parking will be available on the hill behind the fire tower ONLY for those showing off of their trailers.
ALL other parking is available on the infield.
